

Liverpool John Moores University Chancellors Scholarship Award 2019

Scholarship Overview

In order to demonstrate LJMU's commitment to YPC International College as an international partner institution, LJMU would like to offer a full tuition fee scholarship to one of YPC's students or recent graduates enrolling on a Master's degree programme at Liverpool John Moores University in September 2019.

The successful scholar will be chosen based on a competitive shortlisting process.

Eligibility

In order to be considered for the full tuition fee waiver for a full-time Master's degree at LJMU in Liverpool) applicants must:

- be currently studying at or have graduated within the past 3 years from YPC International College (Graduating Year 2017, 2018, 2019)
- Already be in possession of an offer of a place on a full-time PGT Master's degree programme at LJMU.
- Already have the funds to cover the remaining living costs, travel and any other costs associated with studying at the University

The closing date for the Scholarship Application is **21st May 2019**.

Scholarship Application Procedure:

There are two stages to the scholarship application process.

1. The applicant must complete and submit LJMU's online postgraduate course application form via the University's website - <https://www.ljmu.ac.uk/study/postgraduate-students/how-to-apply>
YPC scholarship applicants can choose any LJMU postgraduate course, subject to eligibility. Once students have received their LJMU offer they can move to the second stage.

During stage 1, prospective Masters Students can seek guidance and support with regards to their learning choices.

2. The second stage involves the applicant submitting an electronic word document, and this is their Scholarship Application form, which must contain the completed fields below in this order:
 1. Full Name:
 2. Date of Birth:
 3. Nationality:
 4. The name of the LJMU degree you have completed or are currently studying:
 5. Student ID Number:
 6. Name of the postgraduate degree that you have applied for in the UK:
 7. Explain how you have made a strong contribution to your home institution as a student. (40%)
(Explain in no more than 250 words.)
 8. Explain how you are highly qualified for the programme. (40%)
(Explain in no more than 250 words.)
 9. Describe and evidence how the programme of study will support your career development. (20%)
(Explain in no more than 250 words.)

Deadlines

The closing date for submitting the scholarship application to YPC will be the **21st May 2019**. This then needs to be submitted to LJMU. A decision on who will be awarded a scholarship will be made by the end of June 2019. All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application.
